

## 2010 LEAF PICK-UP SCHEDULE

The Orrville Service Department will begin leaf pick up Monday November 8th, starting with every street south of Market Street. This is scheduled to take one week. If we are not done in one week, we will complete the entire area south of Market Street before moving to the north. On Monday November 15<sup>th</sup>, pick up will begin on every street north of Market Street. This is also scheduled to take one week. If we are not done in one week, we will complete the entire area north of Market Street before beginning a clean up pass.

If you live South of Market Street, have your leaves placed ready for pickup on Monday November 8<sup>th</sup>. If you live north of Market Street, have your leaves placed ready for pickup Monday November 15<sup>th</sup>.

November 22<sup>nd</sup> we will begin a **final** clean up sweep beginning south of Market Street. After the area south of Market Street is complete, we will move to the area north of Market Street. November 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> city crews will be off to celebrate Thanksgiving. November 29<sup>th</sup> pickup will resume where we left off. This clean up sweep is scheduled to be completed on or before December 3rd.

Following are some guidelines to help you and city crews during leaf pickup;

- Leaves should be placed between the curb and sidewalk (on the tree lawn) before crews arrive for pickup.
- If you do not have a tree lawn or yours is very narrow, place the leaves directly behind the sidewalk (on the house side), crews will not rake yards, only piles that are placed for pickup.
- Do not place debris (sticks, trash, stones, etc) in or on the piles as they can injure workers or damage equipment. Debris will not be picked up by city crews. Sticks can be bundled, tied, and placed at the curb for regular curb pickup.
- Do not place piles of leaves on top of holes, rocks, fire hydrants, etc as workers could be injured.
- Crews will not empty bags containing leaves.
- If you have a storm basin in front of or near your property, please keep all leaves off of the top of it to allow storm water to enter the storm system, preventing flooding.
- Leaves can be bagged for pickup with your regular trash.
- Do not park vehicles on the street blocking workers from getting to the leaf piles.

**The Orrville Compost Center will be closed for the season after Wednesday October 27<sup>th</sup>.**

Green Meadows Composting, located at 7541 Rohrer Rd, will be open every Monday–Friday 10:00am-6:00pm and Saturdays from 9:00am-12:00pm for regular business until Dec 6<sup>th</sup>.
