On December 17, 2007, Orrville City Council passed legislation that requires all residents of Orrville, age 18 and older, to file an income tax return with the City starting with the 2007 tax year. This law change removes the exemption previously allowing residents with only interest, unearned income or W2 income from an employer located in the City of Orrville not to file.

The tax rate in effect is 1% with a 1% credit given for taxes paid to other cities. Orrville income tax forms must be filed or postmarked by April 15th. There is a \$50.00 late filing penalty. The City of Orrville will honor federal extensions. If you file a federal extension, please notify the City tax office by providing a copy of the federal extension form.

In January, tax forms will be mailed to all Orrville residents who are on file with our office. While every effort is made to mail a tax form to all taxpayers required to file, it is the taxpayer's responsibility to obtain a form. Tax forms can be obtained at the tax office, during business hours, or from the Orrville Public Library. Forms can also be obtained from the internet at www.orrville.com.

The income tax office is open Monday through Friday from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm to answer your questions and provide assistance with return preparation.
