RESOLUTION NO. 11-14

**A Resolution authorizing the Safety-Service Director to sign an Agreement and/or Agreements on behalf of the City of Orrville for the purchase of salt from the Ohio Department of Transportation for the 2014-2015 season, and declaring an emergency.**

WHEREAS, Section 5513.01(B) of the Ohio Revised Code provides the opportunity for Counties, Townships, Municipal Corporations, Port Authorities, Regional Transit Authorities, State Colleges/Universities and County Transit Boards to participate in contracts of the Ohio Department of Transportation for the purchase of machinery, material, supplies, or other articles; and

WHEREAS, the City of Orrville desires to enact legislation wherein the City of Orrville is authorized to enter into, execute and comply with all the terms and conditions of an agreement with the Director of Transportation for the purpose of purchasing of road salt; and

WHEREAS, the City of Orrville desires to commit to purchasing a minimum of 90 percent and up to 110 percent of the estimated salt tonnage requirements of 1100 tons, exclusively from the vendor awarded the sodium chloride contract for Wayne County by ODOT;

WHEREAS, the City of Orrville also desires to commit to purchasing 200 tons of salt, exclusively from the vendor awarded the sodium chloride contract for Wayne County by the Ohio Department of Transportation, for a summer fill up contract;


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Orrville, County of Wayne, and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City of Orrville shall enter into a participation agreement(s) with the Department of Transportation, and that the Safety-Service Director for City of Orrville be, and is hereby authorized, to execute said agreement and/or agreements substantially in the form attached hereto and incorporated here in as "Exhibit A", providing for the payment by the City of Orrville of the necessary funds for the purchase of road salt;


Section 2: The City of Orrville shall transmit to the Director of Transportation a fully executed copy of this Resolution; and

Section 3: That this Resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the residents of the City of Orrville, and for the further reason that it is required that the contract be returned to ODOT by April 8, 2014, therefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
