Resolution 18 - 12

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE WAYNE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO FILE AN APPLICATION WITH THE OHIO ATTORNEY GENERAL'S OFFICE, TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO MOVING FORWARD GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Attorney General's Office was successful in a settlement with the nation's largest mortgage services over foreclosure abuses, fraud, and unacceptable mortgage practices and has made \$75 million in funding available for residential demolition; and

WHEREAS, the City of Orrville has identified a strategic need within its community and desires to participate in the Program to receive financial assistance for demolition under the Moving Ohio Forward Demolition Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Orrville has the authority to apply for financial assistance and to administer the amounts received from the Ohio Attorney General's Office; and

WHEREAS, the City of Orrville directs and authorizes Lisa Johnson to act in connection with the application and to provide such additional information as may be required;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF ORRVILLE, OHIO:

Section 1: That the City of Orrville authorizes Lisa Johnson as the official representative of the City of Orrville's application to participate in the Ohio Attorney General's Office and provide all information and documentation required in said Application for the Moving Ohio Forward Grant Program; and

Section 2: That the City of Orrville hereby approves filing a grant application under the Moving Ohio Forward Demolition Grant Program by the Wayne County Commissioners; and


Section 3: That the City of Orrville hereby understands and agrees that participation in the Moving Ohio Demolition Grant Program will require compliance with program guidelines; and

Section 4: That the City of Orrville hereby commits itself to provide the match as described in the application and guidelines; and

Section 5: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the reason that the grant application is due to the Ohio Attorney General's Office by June 30, 2012; therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
