A Resolution authorizing the Safety-Service Director to sign an Agreement and/or Agreements on behalf of the City of Orrville, Ohio for the purchase of salt from the Ohio Department of Transportation for the 2015-2016 season, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Section 5513.01 (B) of the Ohio Revised Code provides the opportunity for Counties, Townships, Municipal Corporations, Port Authorities, Regional Transit Authorities, State Colleges/Universities and County Transit Boards to participate in contracts of the Ohio Department of Transportation for the purpose of purchasing of road salt; and

the Director of Transportation for the purposes of purchasing road salt; and authorized to enter into, execute and comply with all the terms and conditions of an agreement with WHEREAS, the City of Orrville desires to enact legislation wherein the City of Orrville is

WHEREAS, the City of Orrville desires to commit to purchasing a minimum of 90 percent and up to 110 percent of the estimated salt tonnage requirements of 1100 tons, exclusively from the vendor awarded the sodium chloride contract for Wayne County by ODOT;

of Transportation, for a summer fill up contract; WHEREAS, the City of Orrville also desires to commit to purchasing 400 tons of salt, exclusively from the vendor awarded the sodium chloride contract for Wayne County by the Ohio Department

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Orrville, County of Wayne, and State of Ohio,

Section 1: The City of Orrville shall enter into a participation agreement(s) with the Department of Transportation, and that the Safety-Service Director for City of Orrville be, and is hereby authorized, to execute said agreement and/or agreements.

and for the further reason that the contract be returned to ODOT in time for ODOT to go out for bids, therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of said City, That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for
