Separate sealed bids for the Heartland Trail, Phase 3 project, a 0.26 mile multi-use concrete trail from along Main Street to Allen Avenue in Orrville, Ohio, will be received by Mr. Steven M. Wheeler, Safety-Service Director, at 207 North Main Street, Orrville, Ohio 44667 until Noon, local time Friday, September 20, 2019, and then, at said office, publicly opened and read aloud. The engineer's estimate for the project is \$144,062.

The City of Orrville will not accept any/or consider any bid as an official bid unless said bidder has picked up and paid for a complete bid package from Shaffer Johnston, Lichtenwalter & Associates. In order to bid this project, you must be a plan holder of record with Shaffer Johnston, Lichtenwalter & Associates.

The Owner reserves the right to waive any informalities. Contract will be awarded based on the lowest and best bid. The City of Orrville may reject any or all bids on any basis and without disclosure of reason. The failure to make such disclosure shall not result in accrual of any right, claim or cause of action by any unsuccessful bidder against the City of Orrville.

Each bid must be accompanied by either an Ohio Revised Code Section 153.571 Bid and Performance Payment Bond in an amount equal to 100% of the bid; or, a cashier's check, bid bond, letter of credit to be duly executed by the bidder as principal and having as surety thereon, a surety company approved by the Owner in the amount of 10% of the bid.

Each bid must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experience on projects of similar size and complexity.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable use Ohio Products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of the Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

Bidders must comply with the prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements in Wayne County and City of Orrville, Ohio as determined by the Ohio Bureau of Employment Services, Wage and Hour Division, 614-644-2239.
