Council President Vance called the council meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

From the Orrville Ministerial Association, Rev. Gary Dehart, Independent Missionary Baptist Church, led the prayer. The pledge was recited.

Roll call. Carr was excused. All others present.

Council minutes of the May 6th regular meeting were presented for approval. Davies motioned to approve those minutes; Squirrell seconds. Shanklin abstained due to absence of that meeting, all remaining ayes; motion passes.

No Standing Committee Reports

Administrative Reports

Mayor Plybon: At the Orrville Elementary, police chief and mayor recognized the May citizens of the month Kaitlyn Miday and Carlos Mejia. Heritage Schools toured city hall, police and fire department. Orrville Elementary kindergartners toured the police and fire departments. This Wednesday, auditions will be held for the Orrville Talent Showcase to open the 2024 Orrville Performing Arts season.

Safety-Service Director Wheeler: The splash pad opens this Saturday at noon. Orr Pool opens June 1st for the season.

Finance Director Strimlan: The Fund Balance report for period ending March 31, 2024 was presented and a motion was requested to approve subject to audit. Shanklin so moved. Seconded by Davies. All ayes. Motion passes.

New Business

Ordinance C-24, Squirrell moved that it be placed on first reading. Shanklin seconds. Ayes all; motion passes. **Ordinance C-24**, An Ordinance amending the Zoning Map created by Chapter 1101 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Orrville, Ohio, to reclassify a parcel of land located on the north side of Hostetler Road (PP# 59-02315.000), consisting of a frontage of 212 feet and a depth of 181 feet in the City of Orrville, Ohio from R-4 (Residential) to I-1 (Industrial).

Discussion: Property owned by the city as well as acres behind this. The two would be combined. It is surrounded by I-1. West is R-4. There is an interested party as industrial. Planning Commission approved it. We will hold a public hearing at the next council meeting.

Resolution 13-24, Squirrell moved that it be placed on first reading. Lax seconds. Ayes all; motion passes. **Resolution 13-24**, A Resolution authorizing the Board of Control to advertise for bids and enter into a contract and/or contracts for the OPWC 2024 Asphalt Street Resurfacing Project in the City of Orrville, Ohio and declaring an emergency.

Discussion: This is the OPWC grant for 2024. Bid packets will go out. We will open the bids. We cannot award the bid until after the grant documents from the State of Ohio which is after the first week in July. This year, we will do the design and engineer in house with our engineer Abbie Wilson. The project this year is Bell from High to Market, Washington from High to Church and McGill from Pine to Paradise. Request approval tonight to move forward.

Squirrell moved that the rules, regulations, and statutes requiring the reading of a Resolution on three separate days be suspended. Shanklin seconded. Ayes all; motion carried. Squirrell

moved that **Resolution 13-24** be adopted as read. Shanklin seconded. Ayes all; motion carried.

Resolution 14-24, Squirrell moved that it be placed on first reading. Davies seconds. Ayes all; motion passes. **Resolution 14-24**, A Resolution to establish the classifications of Firefighter 2 – PT, Firefighter 1/EMTB-PT, Firefighter 2/EMTB - PT, Firefighter 1/EMTA - PT, Firefighter 2/EMTA -PT, Firefighter 2/EMTP – PT, and Planning, Marketing & Development Manager, unclassified service of the City of Orrville, Ohio, and repealing all legislation inconsistent herewith.

Discussion: This legislation is for both the Safety-Service Department and the Utilities. For the fire department, we are clarifying terms used in Resolution 4-24. Most of our firefighters have dual certifications as firefighting as well as EMT certifications. The Planning Marketing Development Manager which is a consolidation of Mike Hedberg’s Marketing Manager position, as he retired, and Kristin Endsley’s Planning Community Development Manager. Kristin will assume the consolidated position. Both positions were a 405 and the new position will move to a 407. Those positions then become obsolete but remain on the books in case something changes in the future. We have the talent to combine these positions at this time, but we don’t know what the future holds. This will go on to second reading.

Good of the Order

Aspiras: Any update on the Human Resources position?

Kirkbride: We are exploring options. We are vetting a law firm to assist with HR needs, labor and such.

Mayor: Bloomin’ Orrville baskets will be hung this week and the planters are being put in. We will have a Memorial Day parade and program on Monday the 27th.


Squirrell moved to adjourn. Lax seconds. Ayes all; motion carried.
