RESOLUTION 30-12

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF THE PUBLIC UTILITIES BOARD TO INTEGRATE THE POWER COST ADJUSTMENT (PCA) FACTOR INTO THE EXISTING RATE SCHEDULE FOR ELECTRIC SERVICE FOR THE CITY OF ORRVILLE.

WHEREAS, the power cost adjustment factor adjusts periodically to account for changes in costs to supply energy; and

WHEREAS, the power cost adjustment (PCA) factor was integrated or "zeroed out" into the rate structures in 2004; and

WHEREAS, the PCA has increased to the point where it is necessary to incorporate it into the basic rate schedules as to not distort the cost of service; and

WHEREAS, after integration, the net effect on the customer's bill is not exact due to rounding, and thus slightly modifies the rates requiring review by City Council; and


WHEREAS, the PCA factor will continue to be reviewed, adjusted, and implemented as needed under the authority of the Public Utilities Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio:


Section 1: That the Director of Utilities of the Public Utilities Board is authorized to integrate the current PCA factor into the existing rate block for all rate schedules.


Section 2: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period provided by law.
