RESOLUTION NO. 35 - 11

A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN, AS PREPARED BY THE WAYNE COUNTY PLANNING DEPARTMENT, EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY AND PREVIOUSLY APPROVED BY FEMA.

WHEREAS, political entities in Wayne County have experienced severe damage from flooding, tornadoes and winter storms on several occasions in the past, resulting in property loss, loss of life, economic hardship and threats to public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, a Hazard Mitigation Plan (the Plan) has been developed through the efforts of the Wayne County Planning Department, the Wayne County Emergency Management Agency and a core committee of volunteers; and

WHEREAS, the Plan recommends hazard mitigation measures that may protect the people and property potentially affected by the natural hazards probable in the City of Orrville; and

WHEREAS, the Plan is required by the Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 and is required for the City of Orrville to qualify under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP), The National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) and the Flood Mitigation Assistance Program (FMA); and


WHEREAS, several public meetings were held to review the Plan during the original planning process, and the updated plan received approval from the Intergovernmental Review (IGR) process on June 10, 2010, and the Wayne County Commissioners adopted the Plan on September 28, 2011.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio:

Section 1: That the Hazard Mitigation Plan, as prepared by The Wayne County Planning Department, Emergency Management Agency, and previously approved by FEMA hereby be approved and adopted for the City of Orrville.

Section 2: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period provided by law.
