

RESOLUTION NO. 48-07

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY – SERVICE DIRECTOR TO FILE AN APPLICATION WITH THE STATE OF OHIO, TO PARTICIPATE IN THE FY07 SMALL CITIES COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT DOWNTOWN REVITALIZATION PROGRAM AND TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Orrville desires to participate in the Program to receive financial assistance for downtown revitalization planning under the FY07 Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Downtown Revitalization Program (hereinafter referred to as the “Program”); and

WHEREAS, the City of Orrville has the authority to apply for financial assistance, to enter into a contract with the State, and to administer the amounts received from the State of Ohio, Department of Development, through its Program, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Orrville must direct and authorize the Safety – Service Director to act in connection with the application and to provide such additional information as may be required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORRVILLE, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Council authorizes the Safety – Service Director as the official representative of the City of Orrville to participate in the Program, and provide all information and documentation required in said Application for submission:

SECTION 2: That the City of Orrville hereby approves filing an application for financial assistance under the Program;

SECTION 3: That the City of Orrville hereby understands and agrees that participation in the Program will require compliance with Program guidelines and assurances.

SECTION 4: That the City of Orrville hereby commits to provide the local share of funding as identified in the Application;

SECTION 5: That Council hereby finds that all actions taken relative to the consideration and adoption of this Resolution were in full compliance with law, including the applicable law relating to “open meetings”; and

SECTION 6: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of said City, and for the further reason that it is necessary to continue to provide a healthy, quality environment to the residents of the City; therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
