

RESOLUTION 50 - 08

A RESOLUTION TO ABOLISH THE CLASSIFICATION OF WATER QUALITY COORDINATOR, TO MODIFY THE CLASSIFICATION DESCRIPTION FOR WATER PLANT OPERATOR II, AND TO ESTABLISH THE CLASSIFICATION OF WATER PLANT OPERATOR III IN THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE, AND TO ESTABLISH THE CLASSIFICATION OF INSTRUMENTATION AND CONTROLS ENGINEER IN THE UNCLASSIFIED SERVICE OF THE CITY OF ORRVILLE, OHIO, AND REPEALING ALL LEGISLATION INCONSISTANT HEREWITH.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio:

Section 1: The classification of Water Quality Coordinator will be abolished at such time as the current position becomes vacant, and the classification of Water Plant Operator II shall be modified to include the duties of the Water Quality Coordinator; the classification of Water Plant Operator III is hereby created in the classified service; and the classification of Instrumentation and Controls Engineer is hereby established in the unclassified service; thereby amending the listing of the classifications as follows:
