RESOLUTION 51-06

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AMENDMENT OF A CERTAIN AGREEMENT WITH WASTE MANAGEMENT OF OHIO, INC., FOR TRASH PICKUP IN THE CITY OF ORRVILLE, OHIO, BY INCREASING THE RATE CHARGED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 14-04, the Director of Service and Safety was authorized to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for the purpose of trash pickup in the City of Orrville, Ohio (hereinafter "City"); and

WHEREAS, the Director of Service and Safety did enter into a contract with Waste Management of Ohio, Inc. (hereinafter "Waste Management") effective January 1, 2005, which provided in part that Waste Management was to receive \$8.28 per month per household for trash and recycling pickup, with the exception that the senior citizens' rate shall be \$7.48 per household per month; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City and Waste Management to amend said contract.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio:

Section One: That the Director of Service and Safety is hereby authorized to amend the aforementioned contract with Waste Management to provide for the City to pay Waste Management the sum of \$9.11 per month per household for trash and recycling pickup, with the exception that the senior citizens' rate shall be \$8.25 per month per household in the City;

Section Two: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the City, and for the further reason that it is necessary to put this increase into effect January 1, 2007, to insure continuity of service; therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
