RESOLUTION NO. 52-14

**A Resolution authorizing the extension of a certain agreement with Kimble Recycling & Disposal, Inc., for trash and recycling pickup in the city of Orrville, Ohio.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 44-14, the Safety-Service Director was authorized to enter into a contract for the purpose of solid waste hauling in the City of Orrville, Ohio (hereinafter "City"); and

WHEREAS, the Safety-Service Director will enter into a contract with Kimble Recycling & Disposal, Inc., (hereinafter "Kimble") effective January 1, 2015, which provides in part that Kimble shall receive \$ 8.37 per month per household unit plus \$40.06 per ton of refuse for trash and recycling pickup; and

WHEREAS, the Safety-Service Director has determined that the negotiated rates for the extension are favorable and will allow City residents to benefit from fixed trash and recycling pickup costs for a period of five (5) years; and


WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City and Kimble to extend said contract through December 31, 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Orrville Ohio:


- Section 1: That the Safety-Service Director is hereby authorized to extend the aforementioned contract with Kimble to provide for the City to pay Kimble the following monthly sums per household for trash and recycling pickup:
  - 2015 - \$8.37 per household unit plus \$40.06 per ton of refuse
  - 2016 - \$8.63 per household unit plus \$41.26 per ton of refuse
  - 2017 - \$8.98 per household unit plus \$42.91 per ton of refuse
  - 2018 - \$<9.43 per household unit plus <45.06 per ton (based on CPI)
  - 2019 - \$<9.90 per household unit plus <47.31 per ton (based on CPI)

Section 2: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period provided by law.
