

RESOLUTION NO. 56-07

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY-SERVICE DIRECTOR TO MAKE DIRECT PAYMENTS TO CONTRACTORS, OR TO REIMBURSE PROPERTY OWNERS, FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK PRIVATE REHABILITATION GRANTS (CDBG) THAT EXCEED \$15,000, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Orrville participates a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program (“the Program”);

WHEREAS, the Program uses federal monies issued to the State of Ohio for grants to downtown Orrville property owners when said owners improve their properties; and

WHEREAS, the Program grants are to reimburse the property owners or pay the property owners’ contractors once the improvements are complete.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio:

Section 1: That the Safety-Service Director is hereby authorized to make direct payments to contractors, or to reimburse property owners, for Community Development Block private rehabilitation grants (CDBG) that exceed \$15,000; and

Section 2: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of said City, and for the further reason that it is necessary to continue to provide a healthy, quality environment to the residents of the City; therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
