RESOLUTION NO. 6-14

A Resolution authorizing the Director of Utilities and/or the Public Utilities Board of Control to enter into a contract without bidding for the replacement of electric distribution truck #37 with a truck which meets the specifications of the City of Orrville and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 4-14 was passed on February 18, 2014, to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for the replacement of electric distribution truck #37 with a truck which meets the specifications of the City of Orrville.

WHEREAS, the electric distribution truck #37 is available for purchase through the Ohio State Purchasing Program/GSA pricing; therefore bidding would not be required per Codified Ordinance 155.02(c)(5).

WHEREAS, Truck No. 37 is nineteen (19) years old and has exceeded the industry average of ten (10) to twelve (12) years of service; and

WHEREAS, said truck is included in the fleet rotation plan and the purchase of its replacement was included in the 2014 budget.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio:

Section 1: That the Director of Utilities and/or Public Utilities Board of Control is hereby authorized to enter into a contract without bidding for the replacement of electric distribution truck #37 with a truck which meets the specifications of the City of Orrville.

Section 2: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate protection and preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the residents of the City of Orrville, and for the further reason that it is necessary for the prompt replacement of necessary equipment for the benefit of Orrville Utilities, and this Resolution shall, therefore, become effective immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
