ENTER INTO A CONTRACT AND/OR CONTRACTS TO PURCHASE ONE (1) ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. ACRE OF LAND FOR WETLAND MITIGATION CREDITS WITH THE U.S. RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY-SERVICE DIRECTOR

WHEREAS, the City of Orrville, Ohio, in the construction of the Raspberry Rd. loop, will disturb some wetlands; and

WHEREAS, the discharge of dredge or fill material into waters of the United States and waters of the State of Ohio, including wetlands, is regulated pursuant to Section 404 of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C. §1344, and/or Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6111; and

of wetland impacts; and States or waters of the State of Ohio, including wetlands, must comply with standards and Environmental Protection Agency ("Ohio EPA") including, in many cases, the mitigation conditions imposed by the Army Corps of WHEREAS, entities planning to place dredged or fill material into waters of the United Engineers (the "Corps") and/or Ohio
