ORDINANCE B-13

AN ORDINANCE VACATING AN ALLEY RUNNING EAST AND WEST NEAR TENNYSON STREET, BETWEEN LOTS 1069, 1070, 1071 AND 2375, IN THE CITY OF ORRVILLE, OHIO.

WHEREAS, the Advance Auto Parts has requested that the following alley be vacated to allow for future construction; and

WHEREAS, this request has been considered and recommended by the Orrville Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the vacation of this alley will not adversely impact the public.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio:

Section 1: This Council hereby finds that the hereinafter described alley, which is also shown on the map attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A, should be vacated, that there is good cause for the vacation of said alley, and that vacation of said alley shall not be detrimental to the general interest:

Situated in the City of Orrville, County of Wayne, and State of Ohio:

Known as being an alley running east and west near Tennyson Street, between Lots 1069, 1070, 1071 and 2375.

Section 2: That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
