

# OFF-LEASH DOG PARK RULES

1. No person may bring into the off-leash area site:
  - (a) Dangerous and/or aggressive dogs, including but not limited to dangerous/aggressive dogs as defined under City of Orrville Ordinance 505.29.
  - (b) Any Presa Canarios
  - (c) Any Pit bull terrier/Pit bull terrier mix
  - (d) A female dog in heat
  - (e) A dog showing any signs of illness
  - (f) More than two (2) dogs at one time
  - (g) A dog without a current license or updated shot records
  - (h) Food or drink of any kind and treats for dogs
  - (i) Any animal other than a dog
  
2. Any person who brings a dog into the off-leash area shall:
  - (a) Use provided materials and implements for removing and disposing of dog excreta and remove all excreta deposited by the dog in the off-leash site
  - (b) Lead the dog on a leash and retain the dog in custody when entering and exiting the off-leash site area
  - (c) Keep the dog under visual and voice control at all times while in the off-leash site
  - (d) Stay in the off-leash area with their dog at all times
  - (e) Fill any holes that the dog digs in the off-leash site as well as other places in the park
  - (f) Remove the dog from the off-leash site at the first sign of aggression
  - (g) Be fully responsible and liable for the behavior and actions of their dog
  - (h) Be able to show proof of current license and updated shot records if asked by City personnel
  - (i) Abide by all other city rules and codes relating to dog ownership and care
  
3. Children under the age of 6 are not permitted in off-leash area. Any person who brings a child between the ages of 7- 11 years of age into off-leash site shall keep the child under strict supervision
  
4. Use of an off-leash site by any dog constitutes:
  - (a) Implies consent of the owner, harborer, or person having care, custody or control of the dog to comply with all conditions and regulations stated in the section or promulgated by City Council and posted at the off-leash site.
  - (b) Implied consent from the owner that the dog has a current license and up-to-date shot records.
  - (c) A waiver of liability to the City of Orrville by the owner, or person having care, custody, or control of the dog, and an agreement and undertaking to protect, indemnify, defend, and hold the City harmless, for any injury or damage caused by the dog during any time that the dog is in the off-leash site.
  
5. Hours of operation: Dawn to Dusk
