- Section 2: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary ordinance shall be in effect immediately after its passage and approval by the timely fashion for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of said City, and for the further reason that it is necessary to pay the city's bills in a and thereby preserve the credit of the city, therefore,
