ORDINANCE H-07

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1144.02 AND SECTION 144.04 OF CHAPTER 144 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ORRVILLE, OHIO, RELATING TO FEES AND USE OF REVENUES FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio:

Section 1: That Section 144.02 of Chapter 144 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Orrville, Ohio, shall be amended as follows:

144.02 FEES

The finance department is hereby authorized to charge residents and non-residents who receive emergency medical and ambulance transport services from the Fire Department the usual, reasonable and customary fees that can be charged for such services. Usual, reasonable and customary fees are defined as the fees established by the Medicare operations insurance carrier for the Medicare locality area Region 7.

Section 2: That Section 144.04 of Chapter 144 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Orrville, Ohio, shall be amended as follows:

144.04 USE OF REVENUE

Fifty percent (50%) of the usual, reasonable and customary fee invoiced or the amount collected, whichever is less, for each occurrence of a person receiving emergency medical service shall be deposited into one or more funds established by Council for the purposes of the acquisition of emergency medical service vehicle(s), equipment, and the payment of the costs of financing the same. All interest earned on the monies deposited in such funds shall be credited to each respective fund.

Section 3: All legislation inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed.

Section 4: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force form and after the earliest period allowed by law.
