ORDINANCE I - 11

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 151.08 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ORRVILLE, OHIO, REGARDING COMPENSATION FOR THE CLERK OF COUNCIL, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE A-09, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio:

Section 1: That Section 151.08 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Orrville, Ohio, entitled Compensation of Elected Officials and Certain Appointed Officers, shall be amended to read as follows:

Clerk of Council beginning 1/01/2012: in such event the Clerk of Council is a current employee of the City of Orrville, said position shall not be compensated separately from said employee's wages paid by the City of Orrville. Rather, said employee shall be compensated for all hours worked for the City of Orrville, including those hours devoted to the position of Clerk of Council, in accordance with all appropriate Fair Labor Standards Wage and Hour Rules. In the event the Clerk of Council is not a current employee of the City of Orrville, the Clerk of Council shall be compensated at the rate of \$4,000.00 per year.

Section 2: All other compensation for officials set forth in Section 151.08 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3: Ordinance A-09 is hereby repealed.

Section 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency for the immediate preservation of the general welfare of the City of Orrville due to the fact that the Council of the City of Orrville is required to have a Clerk of Council to adequately and properly discharge its legislative duties, including the authority to properly compensate the individual appointed to Clerk of Council. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
