ORDINANCE NO. I-14

An Ordinance to authorize the establishment of the City of Orrville, Ohio, First Responders "Shop with a Cop" Program, or its successor program, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, The City of Orrville Police Department and Fire Department, "First Responders", have participated in the Shop with a Cop Program for several years, soliciting donations and selling raffle tickets for donated items to assist underprivileged children in purchasing gifts and spending time with Orrville First Responders; and

WHEREAS The City of Orrville Police Department has previously submitted donations and raffle proceeds to the Wadsworth Police Department Shop with a Cop program for management; and

WHEREAS, Orrville First Responders desire to keep the donations and proceeds local and maintain a local program; and

WHEREAS, the Auditor of the State of Ohio has approved the creation of a new fund to be overseen and maintained by the Orrville Finance Department.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Orrville, Wayne County, Ohio, that:

Section 1: A new fund shall be created for the purpose of collecting, overseeing and maintaining donations and raffle proceeds to be used in the Orrville First Responders Shop with a Cop program, or any successor program of this nature.

Section 2: Declaration of Emergency: Effective Date.

This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City, and for the further reason that this ordinance is required to be immediately effective in order to establish a fund to be overseen by the Orrville Finance Department; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
