ORDINANCE I-18

An Ordinance authorizing the expenditures of certain funds to implement the contract between the City of Orrville and the United City Workers (UCW), and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio:

Section 1: UCW members that work in the Street Department and are required to report to work for snow removal duties shall be paid an annual lump sum payment of four hundred dollars (\$400) on January 18, 2019.

Section 2: UCW members that are required to wear steel toe work boots shall be reimbursed up to one hundred dollars (\$100) annually for the purchase of steel toe work boots with the presentation of a receipt of purchase.

Section 3: All employees shall be paid a one-time lump sum payment of seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750) on January 18, 2019, excluding the Director of Finance, the Director of Safety/Service, the Director of Utilities, the Human Resources Manager, and members of the Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association.

Section 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of said City, and for the further reason that it is necessary to comply with the labor contracts effective as of January 1, 2019, and therefore, this Ordinance shall be effective immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
