ORDINANCE J-10

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RATES OF PAY FOR THE FIREMEN OF THE CITY OF ORRVILLE AND ESTABLISHING SALARIES FOR OFFICERS OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT, REPEALING ALL CONFLICTING RESOLUTIONS AND ORDINANCES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio:

Section 1: That the hourly rate for members of the Fire Department shall be determined by the Fire Chief based on job assignments and training and shall be as follows:

<u>CLASS</u>	<u>RATE</u>
01 Meetings, training, work details, drills, and all working time; and new recruits during probation period.	\$8.00
02 Firefighters with State of Ohio "Volunteer Firefighter" training for fire and EMS runs; and Firefighters with Firefighter #1 and Firefighters #2 with no EMS Certification on EMS run.	\$9.50
03 Firefighters with State of Ohio "Firefighter I" training for fire runs and Foreman of Apparatus while performing technical maintenance on emergency vehicles and equipment.	\$10.00
04 Firefighter with State of Ohio "Firefighter II" training for fire runs.	\$10.50
05 EMT with "basic" training (EMT-A) while on EMS run.	\$11.00
06 EMT with "advanced" training (EMT-I) while on EMS run	\$11.50
07 EMT with "paramedic" training (EMT-P) on EMS run	\$12.00
08 Lieutenants on all emergency runs, meetings, training, work details, and drills.	\$12.50
09 Captains on all emergency runs, meetings, training, work details, and drills.	\$13.00
10 Assistant Chief of the Department on all emergency runs, meetings, training, work details, and drills.	\$13.50

Section 2: That the compensation provided for herein shall become effective as of January 1, 2010.

Section 3: All legislation inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed.


Section 4: That this ordinance is passed as an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of said City and for the further reason that it is necessary to comply with contractual


