## **ORDINANCE NO. J-12**

A EMERGENCY. ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ORRVILLE, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN ORDINANCE **AMENDING** SECTION 181.14 OF HHI CODIFIED

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio:

Section 1: That Section 181.14 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Orrville, Ohio shall read as follows:

## 181.14 ALLOCATION OF FUNDS

thereafter shall be disbursed in the following order: General Fund and the funds collected beginning January 1, 2012, and each tax year The funds collected under the provisions of this chapter shall be deposited in the

- (a) Such part thereof as shall be necessary to defray all costs of collecting the taxes and the cost of administering and enforcing the provisions thereof;
- (b) Not more than seventy-five percent (75%) of the net available income tax receipts received annually may be used to defray operating expenses of the
- <u></u> At least twenty-five percent (25%) of net available income tax receipts received annually shall be set aside and used for capital improvements for the City including, but not limited to, development and construction of storm sewers and street improvements; for public buildings, parks and playgrounds; and for equipment necessary for the police, fire, street, traffic and safety functions.
- Section 2: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of said ordinance shall be in effect immediately after its passage and approval by the timely fashion City, and for the further reason that it is necessary to pay the city's bills in a and thereby preserve the credit of the city, therefore,
