ORDINANCE K - 10

AN ORDINANCE VACATING AN ALLEY THAT ORRVILLE CITY COUNCIL HAS DETERMINED WILL NOT BE DETRIMENTAL TO THE GENERAL INTEREST, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio:

Section 1: This Council hereby finds that the hereinafter described alley, which is also shown on the drawing attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A, should be vacated, that there is good cause for the vacation of said alley, and that vacation of said alley shall not be detrimental to the general interest:

Situated in the City of Orrville, County of Wayne, and State of Ohio, and known as being a north-south alley running between Lot 2333 and Lots 2334 & 3151, and parallel to Mill Street.

Section 2: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate protection and preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the residents of the City of Orrville, and for the further reason that the City of Orrville's largest industry and employer requires vacation of said alley no later than July 19, 2010, in order to continue its expansion on schedule, and this Resolution shall, therefore, become effective immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
