## ORDINANCE L - 12

**AN ORDINANCE VACATING AN ALLEY THAT ORRVILLE CITY COUNCIL HAS DETERMINED WILL NOT BE DETRIMENTAL TO THE GENERAL INTEREST, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS The Orrville Mennonite Church has requested that the following alley be vacated to allow for potential Church expansion,

WHEREAS Council previously passed an ordinance for the vacation of this alley as Ordinance G-12 on March 5, 2012. Due to corrections of the legal description subsequently required by the Wayne County Map Office, it is necessary to replace the previously passed Ordinance with this replacement Ordinance with corrected legal description,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio:

Section 1: This Council hereby finds that the hereinafter described alley, which is also shown on the map attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A, should be vacated, that there is good cause for the vacation of said alley, and that vacation of said alley shall not be detrimental to the general interest:

Situated in the City of Orrville, County of Wayne, and State of Ohio:


Known as being an east-west alley parallel to West Market Street in said City of Orrville, Ohio and further described as follows:


Beginning at the northwest corner of Lot 3452, which is the east line of Cherry Street, extending east 306.90 feet and ending at the northeast corner of Parcel A, at the west line of Orchard Street extended, including that part of Parcel G and H adjoining said alley, as shown on map attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A.


Section 2: That this Resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Orrville, and because it is a replacement for Ordinance G-12, which the Council of the City of Orrville has already passed. Therefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.

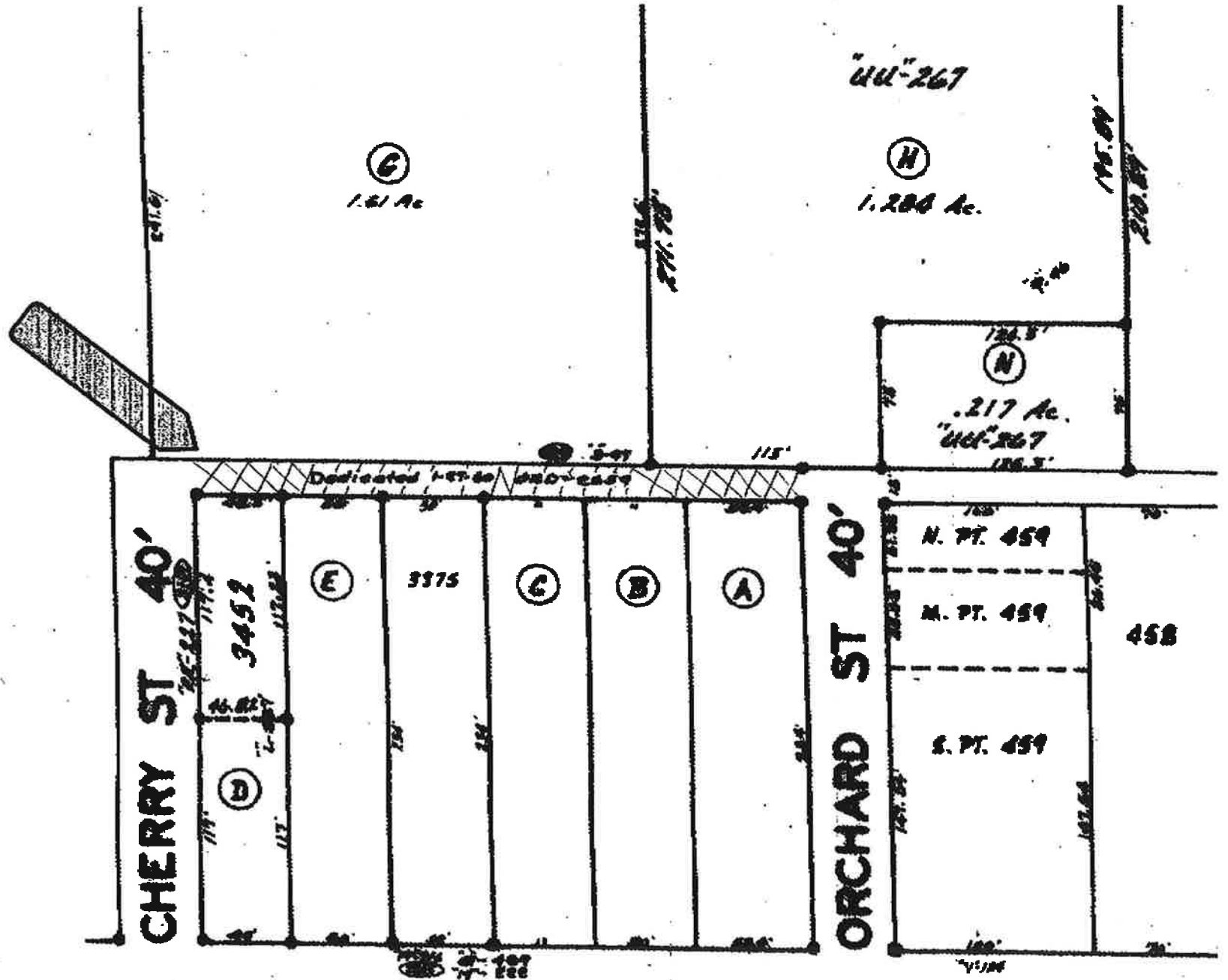
