Standing Committee Reports:

- A. Finance Mr. Miller had no report.
- B. Utilities Mr. Landaw reported that the Public Utility Board approved at the last meeting the purchasing of heater plates for Boiler #12. They are going to get those ordered and get them in time for the April outage when they are doing some maintenance work. These are used to preheat the air to the boiler. The estimated cost is about \$37,000.
- C. Health & Safety Mr. Corfman had no report, but congratulated Sargeant Pauley as being named *Officer of the Year* again.
- D. Parks and Recreation Mr. Purdy had no report.
- E. Transportation Mr. Baker had no report
- F. Planning Mr. Purdy reported that council met last Monday night (02/26/07) for a workshop to discuss the Agricultural Designation Request by Mr. Arnold. The Law Director will be speaking on this.
- G. Ordinance & Personnel Ms. Leathers had no report.

Administrative Reports:

- A. Mayor Mayor Steiner had no report.
- B. Safety Service Director- Director Jewell had no report, but requested a meeting of the Finance Committee to discuss cemetery rates we need to make adjustments in two different areas of the cemetery rates and the other part is to discuss the rates that we charge for emergency squad services. Miller and Council agreed to have a meeting after the workshop after the Utility Board meeting on Monday, March 12th.
- C. Utilities Director Director Preising had no report.

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- D. Finance Director Director Leggett reported the council should have received their booklets for the 2007 Final Appropriations. I ask council to review them and if there were any questions to call him. Hopefully we can get anything answered before we get to the workshop next Monday (03/12/07) evening. So look at those and let me know if there are any question that we can get you information on before the workshop. The other item is that the Safety-Service department received word concerning our ODOT Grant for the alternate truck route which you have been familiar with on the east side of town. The grant amount was for 80% of about a \$550,000 project. That is not the entire project. That is just the traffic study, feasibility study, engineering and all that. As you know this is a large overall project. The reason I mention this is because these numbers - the grant receipts and expenditures – are not in your 2007 Appropriations. At the time these were put together we did not have this final information, but we may have to move fairly quickly on at least making decisions on amending our appropriations. So it is very possible that two weeks from tonight when you approve the final appropriations you may also at that same time have an appropriation amendment to amend the appropriations. That gets a little confusing. We'll explain more of that at the workshop, but just so you know what we know that we have been granted those funds. The ODOT Grant is 80% of the \$550,000 so we will discuss that a little bit at the workshop next Monday night. But just to give you a little heads up so you are not totally surprised when you see an amendment the same night you pass the final appropriations.
- E. Law Director Director Lutz was pleased to report that Mr. Arnold and his wife came into his office on Friday (03/02/07) and signed the easement that the Utilities Department was requesting. So in accordance with our discussions on February 26th, if it is council's pleasure, council can move to accept his application and modify the duration of the Agricultural District designation to one year as opposed to five as we discussed. I would like to thank Mr. Arnold for his cooperation and his agreement to render the situation out at his property and I think this is a good compromise to resolve the issue and give him the years time frame to clean up his property and he understands that. Purdy moved that the Modified Agricultural Designation Application be approved with the annual renewal instead of five year renewal. The reason for this to get the property cleaned up. I would also like to thank the Arnolds for their cooperation on this matter. Baker seconded the motion. Roll call vote. Ayes all. Motion carried.

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F. President of Council – President Handwerk congratulated both high school basketball teams for a fine season. I know both teams planned on going farther than they did in the tournament and that is disappointing for those kids, but they had a fine regular season. Also Jake Strasbaugh and Coach Hostetler's wrestling team as Jake was sixth in the state championships this weekend. Very fine season for him and he is just a sophomore, so he has two more years to go.
