ORDINANCE D-18

An Ordinance establishing the regular meetings of the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 3-81 was passed on January 5, 1981, to establish the regular meetings of the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio.

WHEREAS, custom and changes necessitate certain revisions to said schedule previously established.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio, that:

Section 1: That the regular meetings of the Council of the City of Orrville shall be held on the first and third Monday of each month, unless a quorum is not present on such day. Whenever the date of the regular meeting falls on New Year's Day, Martin Luther King Jr. Day, 4th of July, or Labor Day, regular meetings shall be held on the Tuesday following such holiday. There will be no regular meetings in the month of August.

Section 2: That the meetings shall commence at 7:30 o'clock P.M. official time.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to establish the times for meetings immediately as set forth in Section 2.09 of the Charter of the City of Orrville, and therefore this Ordinance shall be in effect immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
