ORDINANCE NO. M-15

An Ordinance amending Section 151.06 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Orrville, Ohio, regarding uniform allowances, repealing all legislation inconsistent herewith, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio:

Section 1: That Section 151.06 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Orrville, Ohio, relating to police uniform allowances shall be amended to read as follows:


151.06 POLICE UNIFORM ALLOWANCES.

All full-time uniformed officers of the Police Department, including the Police Chief, shall be allowed, in addition to all other compensation, a uniform allowance of one thousand dollars, fifty dollars (\$1,050.00) in calendar year 2016, and one thousand, one hundred dollars (\$1,100.00) in calendar years 2017 and 2018. Additionally, the City shall replace all damaged and excessively worn uniform items and equipment as needed for the Special Response Team and Bike Patrol officers with approval of each item by the Bureau Commander and the Chief.

Section 2: That all legislation inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed; and

Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of said City, and for the further reason that it is necessary to comply with the labor contracts effective as of January 1, 2016, and therefore, this Ordinance shall be effective immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
