ORDINANCE I-21

An Ordinance authorizing the expenditures of certain funds to implement the contract between the City of Orrville and the Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio:

Section 1: OPBA members shall be paid a one-time hazardous workplace payment of three thousand, five hundred dollars (\$3,500) on January 28, 2022.

Section 2: OPBA members that submit a satisfactory receipt for vision services or products shall be paid an annual reimbursement of up to three hundred dollars (\$300) based on each individual member's health enrollment selection.

Section 3: That all legislation inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed; and

Section 4: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the City of Orrville, and for the further reason that it is necessary to comply with the labor contracts effective as of January 1, 2022. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
