ORDINANCE P - 10

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND CONFIRMING THE DEDICATION OF A PORTION OF WEST HIGH STREET IN THE CITY OF ORRVILLE, WAYNE COUNTY, OHIO, TO THE PUBLIC USE FOREVER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio:

Section 1: That a portion of West High Street in the City of Orrville, County of Wayne and State of Ohio, with a width of 30.00 feet beginning on the north side of three parcels designated as Permanent Parcel Numbers 59-02953.000, 59-02954.000, and 59-02955.000, and ending at the center of West High Street in the City of Orrville, Wayne County, Ohio, as shown on attached Exhibit A, is approved and accepted, and that the dedication to public use forever of said streets and utility easements thereon shown, is hereby accepted and confirmed.

Section 2: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of said City, and for the further reason that it is necessary for sidewalk installation to provide a safe environment to the residents of the City; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
