

## **Orr Pool – Summer 2020 Operations**

The City Administration and Orr Pool managers have had discussions regarding the opening of Orr Pool for this summer. We have followed and will continue to follow the State of Ohio and Governor DeWine's orders in regards to outdoor public pool guidelines as our first priority is the safety and health of our residents.

We have made the decision to **open Orr Pool with a opening date of Friday, June 12. Orr Pool will be open Monday through Friday from 12 noon to 7:00 pm, and from 12:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday.** There will be adult swims hours from 11:00 am to 12 noon Monday through Sunday. There will be no swimming lessons this year.

There will be special Friday, July 3<sup>rd</sup> and Saturday, July 4<sup>th</sup> hours to maximize users for the holiday. The hours will be 12 noon to 2:30 p.m., 3:00 p.m.-5:30 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.

Maximum facility capacity will be reduced to allow for appropriate social distancing between users and based on considerations for available deck area, as well as pool surface area. Two three-hour time slots (12 noon – 3:00 pm and 4:00 – 7:00 pm on Monday through Friday, and 12 noon-3:00 p.m. and 3:30 p.m.-6:30 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday) will be available with **up to 100 maximum** entrants on a first come-first serve basis. All entrants will be required to sign a one-time waiver, per family, prior to entry. The break between the time slots will be set aside for cleaning and disinfecting purposes. Users entering the facility together must be from the same household, groups may not be any bigger than ten, and every child under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a parent, guardian or caretaker aged 16 or older.

We will NOT be selling season single or family passes this year. Session passes only will be sold at a reduced rate of \$3.00 for adults, and \$2.00 for children (which will be good for one three hour session). Adult swim (hour only) will be \$2.00. Children under the age of 3 may still enter the pool for free to use the baby wading pool. If you exit the pool during or after the first session of swimming, and wish to re-enter on the same day, you must wait for the next session and pay the session pass rate again.

Signage will be placed throughout the facility reminding users about social distancing, State of Ohio social distancing guidelines, and any additional guidelines we have put into place at our facility. Deck layouts are being revised in standing and seating areas so users can remain at least 6 feet apart from others and spaces will be marked off within the facility to reflect these distancing measures. All pool deck chairs will be removed; however, you are permitted to bring your own personal lawn chairs into the pool deck area, while still maintaining the required social distancing. Restrooms will be open to the public; however, the showers will be closed.
