ORDINANCE Q-06

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE HEMLOCK TRAIL ALLOTMENT DEDICATION PLAT IN THE CITY OF ORRVILLE, COUNTY OF WAYNE, STATE OF OHIO, AND CONFIRMING THE DEDICATION OF ALL STREETS AND UTILITY EASEMENTS SET FORTH THEREON TO THE PUBLIC USE FOREVER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio:

Section 1: That the Hemlock Trail Allotment dedication plat, further described as follows:

Situated in the City of Orrville, Southeast Quarter of Section 25, Township of Green, County of Wayne and State of Ohio, and known as being a platting and numbering of unplatted lands.

is approved and accepted, and that the dedication to public use forever of said streets and utility easements thereon shown, is hereby accepted and confirmed.

Section 2: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of said City, and for the further reason that it is important to maintain good relations with developers and to be able to provide adequate housing for the City's residents; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
