A Resolution adopting the Wayne County Hazard Mitigation Plan developed by the Wayne County Emergency Management Agency and approved by Ohio Emergency Management Agency ("OEMA") and Federal Emergency Management Agency ("FEMA").

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio:

WHEREAS, The City of Orrville is vulnerable to an array of natural hazards that can cause loss of life and damages to public and private property; and

WHEREAS, the City of Orrville desires to seek ways to mitigate situations that may aggravate such circumstances; and

WHEREAS, the development and implementation of a hazard mitigation plan can result in actions that reduce the long-term risk to life and property from natural hazards; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City of Orrville Council to protect its citizens and property from the effects of natural hazards by preparing and maintaining a local hazard mitigation plan; and

WHEREAS, it is also the intent of the City of Orrville Council to fulfill its obligation under Mitigation Planning, of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act to remain eligible to receive state and federal assistance in the event of a declared disaster affecting the City of Orrville; and

WHEREAS, the City of Orrville, in coordination with the Cities of Rittman and Wooster, and the Villages of Apple Creek, Burbank, Congress, Creston, Dalton, Doylestown, Fredericksburg, Marshallville, Mount Eaton, Shreve, Smithville, and West Salem, has prepared a multi-jurisdictional hazard mitigation plan with input from the appropriate local and state officials;

WHEREAS, the Ohio Emergency Management Agency and the Federal Emergency Management Agency have reviewed the Wayne County Hazard Mitigation Plan Update for legislative compliance and has approved the plan pending the completion of local adoption procedures; and

WHEREAS, the Wayne County Commissioners adopted the Wayne County Hazard Mitigation Plan Update on June 27th, 2018 via Resolution # 2018-293;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Orrville Council of the City of Orrville hereby:

Section 1: Adopts the Wayne County Hazard Mitigation Plan Update; and

Section 2: Agrees to take such other official action as may be reasonably necessary to carry out the proposed actions of the Plan.

Section 3: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period provided by law.
