RESOLUTION NO. 20-17

A Resolution authorizing the Mayor to enter into a Partnership Agreement with the City of Wooster and Wayne County for applying to the Ohio Department Services Agency for a Small Cities Community Development Block Grant for Community Housing Impact and Preservation (CHIP) Funds, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio Development Services Agency provides financial assistance to local governments for the purpose of addressing local housing needs for low and moderate income persons, and in conjunction with PY 2017, is urging cities and counties to partner for purposes of receiving and administering funds available under the Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Community Housing Impact and Preservation (CHIP) Program; and

WHEREAS, this City Council desires to enter into a partnership agreement between the City of Orrville, the City of Wooster and Wayne County for purposes of applying to the Ohio Development Services Agency for the purposes of receiving and administering such grant funds for PY 2017.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORRVILLE, OHIO:

Section 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a partnership agreement with the City of Wooster and Wayne County for purposes of applying to the Ohio Development Services Agency for purposes of receiving and administering funds available under the Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Community Housing Impact and Preservation (CHIP) Program for PY 2017.


