WHEREAS, The Plan, a summary of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A, is prepared in accordance with Ohio Revised Code ("ORC") Section 3734, the State of Ohio's Solid Waste Management Plan and the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency's guidelines. The Plan also describes strategies and programs that will be implemented to meet or exceed the minimum state waste reduction goals and objectives. The Stark-Tuscarawas-Wayne Joint Waste Management District ("District") completed the draft amended Solid Waste Management Plan ("Plan") and submitted it to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency for review and comment on December 19, 2017 and the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency provided comments in a non-binding advisory opinion on February 2, 2018. WHEREAS, The District's Policy Committee has reviewed the non-binding advisory opinion received from the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and taken these comments into consideration and incorporated changes into the amended Plan as appropriate. The District has conducted a 30-day comment period from June 1, 2018 to June 30, 2018 and a public hearing was held on July 6, 2018 to provide the public an opportunity to comment on the Plan. WHEREAS, The Plan provides for a fee schedule that generates the required revenue to cover the costs of implementing the strategies and programs designed to meet or exceed the minimum state waste reduction goals and objectives. NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Orrville, located within the jurisdiction of the Stark-Tuscarawas-Wayne Joint Solid Waste Management District, that: The Council of the City of Orrville hereby acknowledges receipt of the amended draft Section 1. Plan; The Council of the City of Orrville approves the District Solid Waste Management Section 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and Section 3. relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Sections 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code; and Section 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of said City and for the further reason that it is necessary to provide for the efficient disposition of waste; therefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
