RESOLUTION NO. 26-16

A Resolution authorizing the Director of Utilities to enter into a contract and/or contracts, without bidding, for engineering and materials for the purchase of materials to upgrade the Power Plant heating system and building structure, and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Orrville, Wayne County, Ohio.

Section 1: That the current heating system at the Power Plant is inadequate to insure equipment will be protected when the plant is not in operation during cold periods.

Section 2: That the units will not be operating continuously due to operational changes related to the EPA settlement.

Section 3: That it is necessary to upgrade the heating, building enclosure and outside systems at the Power Plant to insure the reliability of the equipment and operating systems.

Section 4: That the funds have been appropriated for this project.

Section 5: That this Resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Orrville, and for the further reason that it is necessary to assure the adequate provision of electricity to the citizens of the City of Orrville. Therefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
