RESOLUTION 28-18

A Resolution authorizing the Director of Utilities and/or the Public Utilities Board of Control to bid and enter into a contract for the construction of a new high flow lift station at the wastewater plant and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, a new lift station is required to reduce plant and city sewer line back-up during high influent events. Currently the plant uses 4 raw pumps at a pumping capacity of 11.5 MGD. The proposed 2 pump lift station will increase total maximum pumping capacity to 21 MGD. This proposed lift station will discharge directly into the plant's 3rd equalization basin which will result in an improved and more efficient treatment process during high flows, while reducing plant and city back-ups.


WHEREAS, the estimated cost is \$389,000.00, which includes engineering, permitting fees, material and construction costs. Funds are included in the 2018 and 2019 budgets.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio:

Section 1: That the Director of Utilities and/or Public Utilities Board of Control is hereby authorized to bid and enter into a contract for repairs and painting of the west water tower.

Section 2: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate protection and preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the residents of the City of Orrville, and for the further reason that the prompt repair and maintenance of infrastructure is critical to the efficient management of the City's resources, and this Resolution shall, therefore, become effective immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.


