RESOLUTION NO. 4-17

A Resolution authorizing the Director of Utilities and/or the Public Utilities Board of Control to enter into a contract without bidding, for the replacement of electric distribution truck #58 with a truck which meets the specifications of the City of Orrville and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the replacement of electric distribution truck #58 is available for purchase through the Ohio State Purchasing Program/GSA pricing; therefore bidding would not be required per Codified Ordinance 155.02(c)(5).

WHEREAS, electric distribution truck #58 was due to be replaced in 2018, however, a recent inspection revealed the unit sub-frame, where the boom attaches, has deteriorated. Therefore, due to the safety risk, it is required that said truck be replaced in 2017.


WHEREAS, an adjustment will be made to the 2017 final appropriations of the City of Orrville, for the purchase of a replacement truck for electric distribution truck #58.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio:

Section 1: That the Director of Utilities and/or Public Utilities Board of Control is hereby authorized to enter into a contract without bidding for the replacement of electric distribution truck #58 with a truck which meets the specifications of the City of Orrville.

Section 2: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate protection and preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the residents of the City of Orrville, and for the further reason that it is necessary for the prompt replacement of necessary equipment for the benefit of Orrville Utilities, and this Resolution shall, therefore, become effective immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
