During the period of the moratorium, no existing business in the City may establish cultivation, processing, or retail opening, using any land, or devoting any floor area of the business for the purposes of the permit, certificate of occupancy, or any other permit shall be granted to a business for sale of medical marijuana.

SECTION FOUR: That for the purpose of this Resolution, "medical marijuana" shall have the same meaning as that term is defined in Section 3796.01(A)(2) of the Ohio Revised Code, effective September 8, 2016.
