

## Resolution 15-22

---

**A Resolution authorizing the Board of Control to enter into a contract with B&C Communications, without bidding, for the purchase of tornado siren software, and declaring an emergency.**

**WHEREAS**, tornado sirens are a critical tool to notify residents of the need to go indoors during a storm event; and

**WHEREAS**, tornado season in Ohio is starting soon and it is imperative to have the new system installed as soon as possible.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio:

Section 1: That the Board of Control is hereby authorized to enter into a contact with B&C Communications, without bidding, for the purchase of tornado siren software, and declaring an emergency.

Section 2: That this Resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the City of Orrville, and for the further reason that the tornado siren system is critical to alerting our citizens to dangerous storm activity. Therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
