

Resolution 16-22

A Resolution authorizing the Director of Finance of the City of Orrville, Ohio, to enter into a Debt Collection Agreement with the Ohio Attorney General Collections Enforcement Office, for the purpose of collecting outstanding fees for ambulance services and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the City of Orrville has requested that the Ohio Attorney General undertake the collection of delinquent debt owed to the City of Orrville, for ambulance services, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 131.02. The Delinquent Debt Collection Agreement between the Ohio Attorney General and the City of Orrville, Ohio, is attached.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio:

Section 1: That the Director of Finance of the City of Orrville, Ohio, is hereby authorized to enter into a Debt Collection Agreement with the Ohio Attorney General Collections Enforcement Office and declaring an emergency.


Section 2: That this Resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the City of Orrville, and for the further reason that timely collection of unpaid obligations to the City are important for sound fiscal management and budgeting purposes. Therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
