

Resolution 16-23

A Resolution authorizing the Director of Utilities and/or Public Utilities Board of Control to enter into a contract and/or contracts, without bidding, for the purchase of three (3) influent pumps, motor control centers and related components and services for the wastewater treatment facility and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the current pumping systems were installed in the early 1980's and are undersized and need replacement due to age and wear. The new systems will be more efficient using variable speed drives, provide higher pumping capacities and provide more operational flexibility; which will match the manufacture of a recently replaced pump system providing maintenance and spare parts economies; and

WHEREAS, this project has been included in the budget and will mostly be funded by the American Rescue Plan Act.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio:

Section 1. The Public Utilities Board of Control is hereby authorized to enter into a contract and/or contracts, without bidding, for the purchase of three (3) influent pumps, motor control centers and related components and services for the wastewater treatment facility.

Section 2. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the residents of the City of Orrville, Wayne County, Ohio, and for the further reason that it is necessary to provide ongoing maintenance of the wastewater treatment facilities. Therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
