

Resolution 17-22

A Resolution authorizing the Director of Utilities and/or the Public Utilities Board of Control to advertise for bids and enter into a contract and/or contracts for the purchase of major hardware, software, and agreements of maintenance support and/or consultation required by the City of Orrville and the Department of Public Utilities, to comply with current software requirements and cyber security insurance regulations and declaring an emergency.

Section 1: That the Public Utilities Board of Control and the City of Orrville Board of Control are hereby authorized to advertise for bids and enter into a contract and/or contracts for the purchase of major hardware, software, and agreements of maintenance support and/or consultation.

Section 2: That this Resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the City of Orrville, and for the further reason that upgrades of various software and hardware components are critical for the functioning of the public utilities and to effectively make purchases in the marketplace. Therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
