

Resolution 18-22

A Resolution declaring the necessity of constructing sidewalks on certain properties in the City of Orrville, Ohio.

WHEREAS, the City adopted a Sidewalk Installation Policy in 1997, stemming from a Citizen Sidewalk Advisory Committee that established a points system and priority schedule for the installation of sidewalks within the City; and

WHEREAS, three phases of sidewalk installation within the City have been completed since that time, and there remains one final group of streets that have not yet had sidewalks installed; and

WHEREAS, there has been an increase in pedestrian and vehicular traffic at the locations indicated herein as a result of development in those areas; and

WHEREAS, this City Council believes that sidewalks in developed areas are essential to the safety of pedestrians traveling therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio:

Section 1: That it is necessary to construct certain sidewalks at the following locations in the City of Orrville, Ohio:

- Viking Avenue, north and south sides, from N. Crown Hill Road to western terminus;
- Heights Avenue, east and west sides, from Lakeview Drive to northern terminus;
- Heatherwood Lane, east and west sides, from Viking Avenue to Meadow Lane;
- Lakeview Drive, north and south sides, from Heatherwood Lane to Magnolia Lane;
- Primrose Lane, north and south sides, from Heatherwood Lane to Meadow Lane;
- Kenwood Drive, north and south sides, from Lee Drive to N. Crown Hill Road;
- Lee Drive, east and west sides, from Meadow Lane to Lynn Drive;
- Tammy Court, east and west sides, from Kenwood Drive to southern terminus;
- Magnolia Lane, east and west sides, from Lakeview Drive to Kenwood Drive;
- Lynn Drive, north and south sides, from N. Crown Hill Road to western terminus; and
- Meadow Lane, north and south sides, from N. Crown Hill Road to Heatherwood Lane.

Section 2: That the plans, specifications, and estimate of cost for the construction now on file in the office of the Clerk of Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio, are approved; and

Section 3: That the owners of each lot and parcel of land bounding the abutting on the proposed sidewalks shall construct that portion of the sidewalks that abut their respective properties, in accordance with the plans and specifications filed in the office of the Clerk of Council, within three (3) years after service of notice of the passage of this Resolution.

Section 4: That in the event any such abutting property owner does not complete the construction of that portion of such sidewalks that abut his property in accordance with the plans and specifications and within the time prescribed, this Council will cause it to be done and the entire cost assessed on the property of the abutting property owner.

Section 5: That the Clerk of Council is directed to serve notice of the passage of this Resolution on the owners of the lots and land abutting on the sidewalks as provided by law.

Section 6: That Council finds and declares that all formal actions concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution occurred in an open meeting of this Council of its committees, in compliance with law.

Section 7: That this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
