RESOLUTION 20-20

A Resolution authorizing the sale of retired K-9 Officer Freddie to his handler for the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00); and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Freddie is a K-9 officer serving the Orrville Police Department since 2012;
and

WHEREAS, Freddie was trained and has remained with his handler since joining the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the working life of a K-9 officer generally ranges from between five to seven years and Freddie has been an officer for more than eight (8) years; and

WHEREAS, Freddie will retire from the Orrville Police Department on June 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, in light of the above facts, upon Freddie's retirement he will no longer be needed for municipal purposes and may be sold as "personal property" of the City; and

WHEREAS, in Ohio and throughout the country, it is the general policy and practice that a K-9 officer who has retired from the Department would be sold to his or her handler for One Dollar (\$1.00).

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Board of Control is hereby authorized to execute an agreement to sell retired K-9 Officer Freddie to his handler, Officer Michael Smith for the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00). Said agreement shall include a waiver and release and shall be approved as to form by the Law Director.

Section 2: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of said City, and such emergency being the need for Freddie to continue to have a home with his handler without interruption. Therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
