

# Resolution 20-22

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**A Resolution authorizing the Board of Control to enter into an agreement and/or agreements with the State of Ohio Purchasing Cooperative, Department of Administrative Services to purchase one (1) 2022 or 2023 Ford Police Interceptor Utility V6 AWD Vehicle; or alternatively to purchase said vehicle from another dealer upon equivalent terms, conditions and specifications, but at a lower price than it can be purchased through the State Contract as allowed by Ohio Revised Code Section 125.04 and enter into an agreement and/or agreements for said purchase, and declaring an emergency.**

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio:

Section 1: That Board of Control is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement and/or agreements with the State of Ohio Purchasing Cooperative, Department of Administrative Services to purchase one (1) 2022 or 2023 Ford Police Interceptor Utility V6 AWD Vehicle; or alternatively to purchase said vehicle from another dealer upon equivalent terms, conditions and specifications, but at a lower price than it can be purchased through the State Contract as allowed by Ohio Revised Code Section 125.04 and enter into an agreement and/or agreements for said purchase.

Section 2: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate protection and preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the residents of the City of Orrville, and for the further reason that a police vehicle is needed to provide services to the residents of the City of Orrville, and it is critical to timely place an order due to anticipated supply issues. Therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
