Resolution 23-23

A Resolution authorizing the Safety – Service Director to enter into any agreements with the Ohio Department of Transportation necessary for the Orrville Pavement Marking project (PID 11651) and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Section 5501.03 (C) of the Ohio Revised Code provides that the Director of the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) may coordinate the activities of the Department with other appropriate public authorities and enter into any contracts with such authorities as necessary to carry out its duties, powers and functions; and

WHEREAS, the Orrville Pavement Marking project is a transportation activity eligible to receive federal/state funding; and

WHEREAS, the LPA (City of Orrville) has received funding approval for this project listed above from the Program Manager having responsibility for the federal/state funds involved; and

WHERAS, it is the mutual desire of both ODOT and the LPA to the have the LPA serve as the responsible lead agency for the administration of the project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio:

- Section 1: That the Safety Service Director is hereby authorized to enter into any agreements with ODOT necessary for the above-mentioned improvements.
- Section 2: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation for the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the City of Orrville, and for the further reason that capital improvements are essential to the functioning of the City. Therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage by Council and approval by the Mayor.
