RESOLUTION 25-21

A Resolution authorizing the Board of Control to enter into an agreement and/or agreements with the State of Ohio Purchasing Cooperative, Department of Administrative Services to purchase one (1) 2021 or 2022 GMC Sierra 2500 or alternatively to purchase said vehicle or a Ford F-250 from another dealer upon equivalent terms, conditions and specifications, but at a lower price than it can be purchased through the State Contract as allowed by Ohio Revised Code Section 125.04; or alternatively to advertise for bids and enter into an agreement and/or agreements for said purchase, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, historically the City of Orrville has purchased Ford vehicles through State purchasing, or through a local vendor at a lower price than the State purchasing price; and

WHEREAS, Ford was not awarded the State purchasing contract in 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Service Department fleet is all Ford trucks; and

WHEREAS, the City mechanics have a familiarity and expertise in maintaining and repairing Ford vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Ford F-250 has a higher payload and towing capacity than a GMC Sierra 2500; and

WHEREAS, a local Ford vendor has provided a lower quote than the State bid pricing as permitted by O.R.C. Section 125.04; and

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Orrville, Ohio:

Section 1: That Board of Control is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement and/or agreements with the State of Ohio Purchasing Cooperative, Department of Administrative Services to purchase one (1) 2021 or 2022 GMC Sierra 2500 Vehicle; or alternatively to purchase said vehicle or a Ford F-250 from another dealer upon equivalent terms, conditions and specifications, but at a lower price than it can be purchased through the State Contract as allowed by Ohio Revised Code Section 125.04; or alternatively to advertise for bids and enter into an agreement and/or agreements for said purchase.

Section 2: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate protection and preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the residents of the City of Orrville and for the further reason that a service department vehicle is needed to provide services to the residents of the City of Orrville and this Resolution shall, therefore, become effective immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
